Registration Requirements for New Students/Parents

The International School of Cambridge welcomes students from any ethnic, racial background, or faith. The most important point is to ensure that any student accepted is capable of handling a strong academic curriculum successfully. Acceptance at the International School of Cambridge involves a selective process to maintain the high quality standards of the school.

Parents are required to provide the following:

At the time of Registration:

- ❖ Registration Form – duly filled
- ❖ Payment of Entrance Fee

At the time of Enrolment

- ❖ Enrolment Contract
- ❖ Copy of previous year's final report card or current year's last report card (for SK - Gr.8)
- ❖ Copy of immunization record
- ❖ Copy of Health card
- ❖ Copy of child's Birth Certificate, PR Card or Passport
- ❖ Financial Agreement Form
- ❖ Payment of Materials Fee and EQAO (if applicable) Fee (Gr. 3 & 6 only)

Upon registration and payment of the Entrance Fee, the child will be given a date to write the Entrance Exam. The decision to admit a new student will be based on a number of factors:

- ❖ Entrance Exam
- ❖ Interview with the child and parent(s)
- ❖ Previous report cards

Once the exam is completed, a decision on acceptance will be made and a letter will be mailed to each child's parent/guardian. At that time, the child's parent/guardian will be asked to come into the school to complete enrolment and pay the Materials and EQAO fees.
